Crunch matches coming up for Seniors, Juniors and Hurlers

Following a disappointing defeat at the hands of St. Patrick's last Friday night, Killeavy's senior footballers now have just two games left in which to gain the necessary point(s) that would save them from relegation to the intermediate league. Our two remaining games are both at home, Dromintee this Sunday followed by the last match against title chasing Armagh Harps on September 5th. The situation at the bottom of the table is incredibly close with five teams being separated by just one point. Three teams will be relegated and at the moment we are occupying one of those three places.
