



Work starts on 3G Project



The tender to construct Killeavy's 3G facility, outdoor gym and community walking track has been won by Banbridge company, McAvoy Construction. McAvoy's have lots of experience of this type of contract, having previously been involved with high profile projects including the Mary Peter's track and St. Colman's, Newry. They have already started on site and the plan is for the work to be completed by the end of March.

The club has received a grant from Newry, Mourne and Down Council for £77,000 towards the project and we hope to make up the shortfall (in the region of £100,000) through the proceeds of Strictly Come Killeavy, our February 20th Race Day and the ongoing contributions of Club Killeavy patrons.

The project is Phase 5 of our 10 year plan which has already seen us invest in an academy playing field, new boundary fencing, new changing rooms and a refurbishment of the youth club and car parking facilities. We seek to have the best possible facilities for the youth of our parish and we thank you all for the support without which it would not happen.

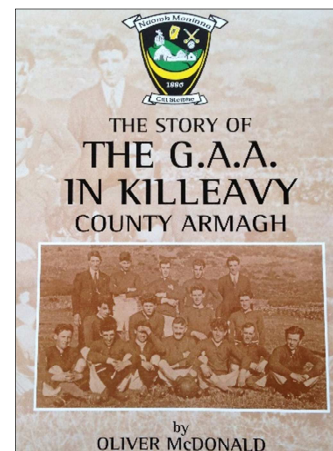
