The second half was the best football the girls had played so far this year and they competed fiercely in all sectors of the field and led going into the dying minutes but were overtaken when an unstoppable shot found the top corner of the net to give Cruppen a two point winning margin. Final score Cruppen 2.04 Killeavy 2.02. Not to be disheartened the Killeavy girls went on to beat the other team in the group 5.04 to 3.02 with all 20 girls involved in the three matches. A great effort by them all and notable that our group opponents actually went on to contest the final with Cruppen edging out Harps in the final.
