Seniors lose unbeaten record

After three wins to start their season, Killeavy's senior footballers came down to earth with a mighty bang last Friday night in Silverbridge. Coming into the game, both teams had 100% records but after an hour of almost total dominance, it was Silverbridge who extended their winning run while Killeavy were left to ponder not only a disappointing result but a strangely flat performance all round.

Playing with the wind, Killeavy started fairly well and took an early lead through a fine Barry McKeivitt point and a really well worked Darren O'Hanlon goal. We failed to build on this advantage however and allowed Silverbridge to take control. Five points in a row gave them the lead and a Raymond Teggart free was only a short respite before the home team scored the goal that their excellent support play deserved. Three more points were added on before a Míceál McNamee free gave Killeavy some hope just before the break.

The second half was more of the same with Silverbridge owning the middle of the field and launching attack after attack on a hard pressed defence. The 'Bridge added a second goal and in fairness could have added at least two more but for miraculous last ditch defending. They added points at ease and the game was long over as a contest before Darren O'Hanlon claimed a consolation goal from the penalty spot.

We don't have any time to lick our wounds after this mauling as we have to stand up for another tough encounter tonight when Culloville are the visitors to the Memorial Park.
