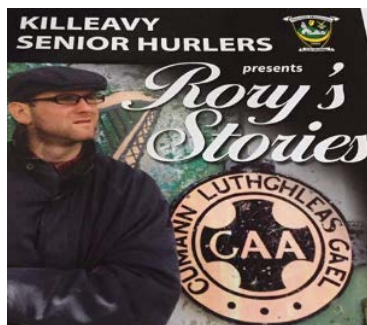
Gaeltacht Scholarships
