U14s just miss out on Féile glory

Our u14 footballers pitted themselves against the best in the country and came out with their heads held high after a fantastic weekend in Cork and Kerry.

Killeavy were playing as Armagh champions in Division 2 of the competition facing up to 16 other teams drawn from 10 different counties. In their group stages, they started their campaign on Friday evening by playing the Offaly champions Na Fianna and this proved to be a very intense low scoring encounter which Killeavy just edging home by 0.05 to 0.03. Next up was a match against Cork's Eire Og which was played on their opponents home field in Ovens. Killeavy were well warmed up by now and played some scintillating stuff to run out comfortable winners.

Saturday morning saw Killeavy take on their host club Ballincollig who put up a real good fight and it took a couple of goals at opportune moments to see us through by 3.06 to 1.06. This result meant that we had topped our group and through to the divisional quarter-final in Mallow. As it happened, for the third time in the weekend we faced a home team on their home field. Despite this slight disadvantage, Killeavy managed to come through relatively unscathed to win by 7 points and so record their fourth win in two days.

Saturday night saw the boys off to Carrigaline to take part in the traditional Féile parade through the town before heading back to Ballincollig and a night of entertainment in the clubhouse.

Sunday was the climax of the tournament with all the finals happening in Killarney. Killeavy still had to negotiate the semi-final however and travelled to Glenflesk to play against their old friends from Friday night, Na Fianna, who had won their way through the other side of the draw. Whereas on the first occasion, Na Fianna had tested Killeavy all the way; this time Killeavy were in control throughout the match and although Na Fianna narrowed the gap at the end, Killeavy held on to win by 1.08 to 0.07 and a place in the divisional final against Castlebar Mitchels.

The final was played in the magnificent Fitzgerald Stadium, home of Kerry football but also home to a gale force wind that howled straight down the pitch. Whoever won the toss was always going to play with that advantage and as it happens, that choice went to Castlebar. The first half was one way traffic with the Mayo champions launching high balls in and around a beleaguered defence and by half-time they had built a decisive lead. Try as they might against a packed defence in the second half, a very tired Killeavy team could just not overhaul the first half deficit.

Our lads should be very proud of the way they conducted themselves both on and off the field. They have shown that they can compete with the best in Ireland and we hope to see them mature their skills and attitudes to bring further credit to themselves and their club in the years ahead. Many, many thanks to all the parents and family members who made the trip to support the team; to our coaches for all they do not only this weekend but throughout the year and to our sponsors who really looked after the team. A final thanks to our new friends from Ballincollig who did everything they could to ensure the boys enjoyed the weekend.
