Killeavy's senior team returned to action after the summer break with an away fixture in Whitecross last Sunday afternoon. Other than long term injury still afflicting Ciaran O'Hanlon and Caolan McConville, the team were fairly much at full strength and obviously hoping to begin building towards their championship fixture coming up at the end of the month.

Killeavy were caught cold right at the start of the game as Whitecross got off to the perfect start with a goal from the penalty spot with their first attack of the game. It took a few minutes for Killeavy to settle after this but when they did, Jamie Cosgrove launched the fight back with a well taken point. We were well on top early on but chance after chance went begging until Raymond Teggart muscled his way through to fire home to the roof of the net. However, instead of capitalising on their advantage, Killeavy allowed Whitecross back into the game and conceded six of the next eight points with four coming directly from short range frees needlessly given away.

Three points down at half time, any hopes of a revival were dashed when Whitecross scored the first three points of the half that was to give them what turned out to be an unassailable lead. Try as they might, points from Thomas Hannaway, Paul Quinn (2) and Míceál McNamee (2) were not sufficient to claw back the deficit. In the end, Whitecross were able to tack on a couple of points to make the game safe at 1.11 – 1.08.

Killeavy now have three games in eight days and will be looking to make sure that they stay injury free and suspension free as well as improving current form before their championship clash with Eire Og on 27th August.
